Ravikumar Balkrishan Sethi was born July 30, 1945 and passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, May 26, 2020. He was the loving husband of Teresa, father of Sean (Catherine) and Lisa (Boban) Korunoski, and a grandfather to Bianca and Antonio Korunoski.

Ravi was a caring, compassionate and principled person who was loved and admired both at work and at home. He carried himself with dignity and always had a smile on his face.

Ravi was born in Bombay, India. He was the middle child of 3 boys. Ravi was close to both of his brothers, Vijay and Anil.

Ravi attended the Goa College of Pharmacy and earned his BS in Pharmacy. His fierce intelligence and determination took him to the U.S. in 1970 where he attended the University of Iowa earning his Masters degree in Pharmacy. He was proud to be mentored by Dr. Keith Guillory with whom he always kept in touch.

He accepted a research position with Parke-Davis & Co. in Detroit, Michigan in 1974. In his early years at Parke-Davis he was instrumental in the research and manufacturing, which he later went into, of dozens of successful products. While advancing his career, he met the person who would become the love of his life, Terry.

In 1979, Ravi and Terry were married on Groundhog Day. Their journey took them away from Michigan. Their son Sean was born while in New Jersey and they ended up finally in Lancaster, PA. Then they had their beautiful daughter, Lisa.

Ravi lived his life as a dedicated husband, father, grandfather, brother and friend. He cared deeply about everyone who came into his circle and left a legacy of kindness and compassion that will be remembered always.
